

Incorporating ICT Industry Certifications into the Specialist High Skills Major

The Specialist High Skills Major (SHSM) is a specialized, ministry-approved program, developed by the Ontario Ministry of Education, that allows students to customize and focus their learning on a specific economic sector while meeting the requirements to graduate from secondary school. SHSM also assists students in their transition from secondary school to apprenticeship training, college, university, or the workplace.

The SHSM program is available in all public school boards across Ontario.

How is the Specialist High Skills Major recognized?

Students who successfully complete an SHSM receive an Ontario Secondary School Diploma with an embossed seal of completion, a SHSM Record documenting the student's achievement, and a formal recognition on the student's Ontario Student Transcript.

The SHSM program meets the needs, interests, and strengths of all students. It engages them in learning and better prepares them for graduation and beyond.
